



The horary prediction of the “Super Bowl” Winner

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This article is an example of horary chart but it is, more than all, the intent to show that we can successfully ask about all we want in horary charts, including football games and sports in general, even if we are not personally interested in some team.

I'll give you an example of a sport chart that I analyzed successfully referring to the question: “Who will win the Super Bowl, The Patriots or the Giants?”

The major winter sports event in the USA was played in February, 2008. It involved the New England Patriots and their 18 straight victories in a single season vs. the New York Giants.

The Patriots are a 14 point Favorite. In other words, if you chose to back the Patriots with a wager, they would have to win by more than the 14 point spread. They are the underdogs and they have a betting handicap.

Giants have very slim chance and they could pull this off.

The chart was cast for the moment of the question:

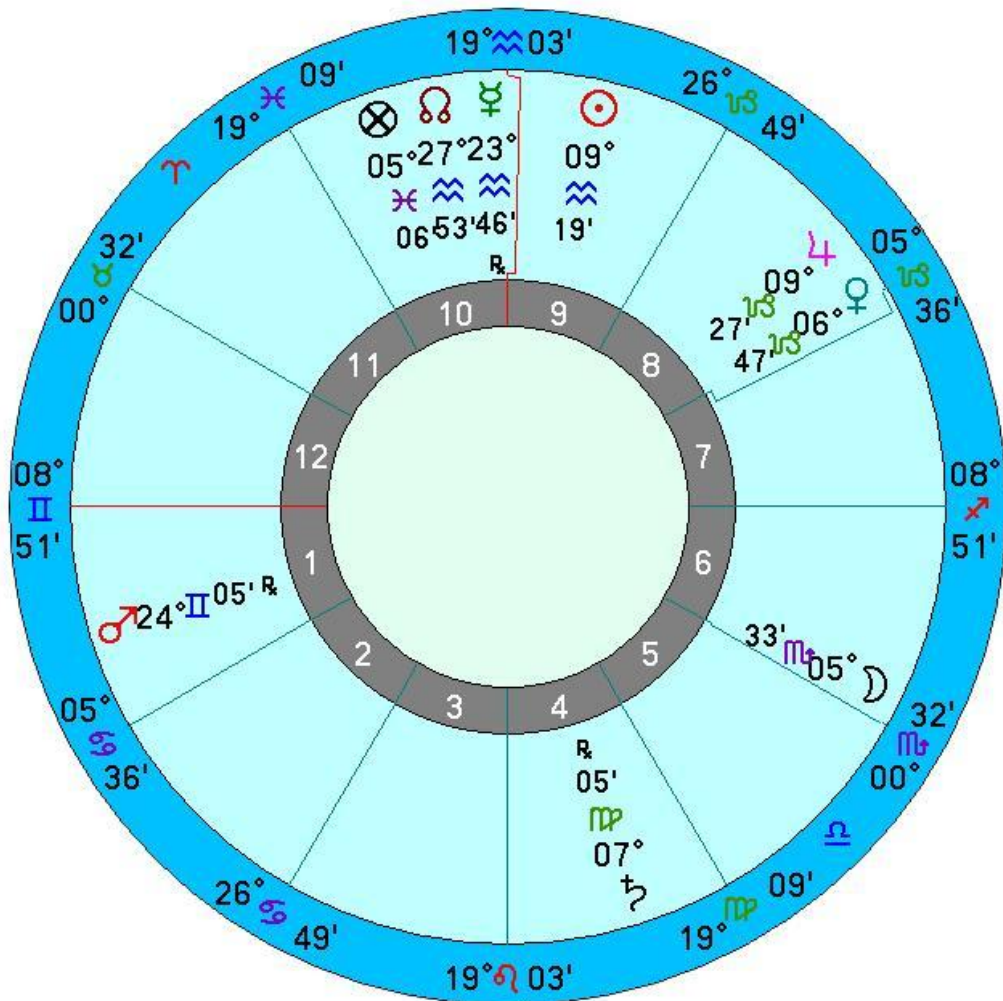
"Who wins the Super Bowl, the Patriots or the Giants?"

The question was asked at 29 January 2008

12:45 PM

PST +8:00:00

Los Angeles CA



It was a question posted in the Yahoo's group "Angelicus Merlin" and even not having a personal interest I

The favorite, the Patriots, were the team at home field, so they were represented by the first house, Gemini. The Giants, as the underdogs, got the 7th house, Sagittarius.

My initial delineation was according with other list's members:

Initially I wrote:

"The game is clear: the Patriots win. But it will be a tough game, the Moon does not favor the Patriots, neither the Giants: the Moon is against all... but she prefers Mars, in the Patriots house.

May be the Moon will give a hard time to both. Her last aspect was with Mars, a trine with reception by detriment(the Moon was in Libra, Mars detriment.)

Not considering the Fortuna, the next aspect is with Venus, again a mutual reception by detriment.

And Venus is the exaltation ruler of the 11th of Patriots. If Venus doesn't represented a frustration, since that according with Masha'allah benefics doesn't impede, she goes increasing in degrees and reaches Jupiter: she receives Jupiter by detriment: point against Giants. Besides this the situation for the Giants is awful: the ruler in the 2nd, in aversion, the Moon is in the 12th, the Sun, ruler of their derivated 10th, Leo, is in fall, and the South Node is also in Leo.

I have a lot of secondary considerations, but to summarize the Patriots will win!"

That was my first delineation.

But something was bothering me. I know some modern authors as John Frawley used to give the 9th radical to university's issues and the 10th radical for the job, even in derivated charts, i.e. even if you ask about the university or the job of a third person. I always believed it was more consistent to derivate the houses...but reading Masha'allah's "On Reception" I observed that first of all he read the radical houses. Just in case, I nailed the chart using the 10th for the triumph of both. I knew the result of that game would be an answer to several theory questions I had about the importance of the radical place of the planets and houses/or derivated.

The Patriots were the first house, ruled by Mercury, well placed in the 10th, the winner's house. That was a positive testimony favoring The Patriots.

The Moon was in the 6th house, making a Translation of Light from Venus to Saturn (ruler of MC) reaching the Sun and finally to the "all magnificent and benefic" (even in fall) Jupiter.

The Translation of Light was in favor of the Giants, represented by Jupiter, since it linked Saturn, the Midheaven's ruler to Jupiter, the ruler of the 7th, and Jupiter received Saturn by rulership.

So, the Giants were ruled by a superior planet, and the Moon was "looked" from that superior planet, even if the Moon was not in a profitable places, the 6th. But Jupiter was in a profitable house, the 8th, a succedent house.

Jupiter was in the house of the Giant's army, the second of the 7th and received the TOL of the Moon (that would carry the light of the Sun, ruler of the 4th, the end of the matter, to Jupiter, that would receive Saturn's rays, the victory, directly to it!)

So, I saw that giving the 10th house for both sides we shall conclude that the Giants will win.

What changed the result in that last delineation is that in this case, differently from the earlier, **and I want to stress it**, I picked up Saturn as the victory's significator, for both teams, the lord of the 10th house.

And the second delineation was the right one! The Giants won.

Here you have what I wrote to the list:

"I was thinking about the subject of using or not the derivate 10th, and I have to say that after thinking and meditating about what I have been studying on Masha'allah technique, I'm afraid I have to conclude that the best is to use always the radical and not the derivate houses. We don't need them, and frequently they confuse our mind.

If it's a contest, the lord of the sign with more dignities in the MC, or applying to a planet in MC, or the MC's ruler, will win.

If you read On Reception, Masha'allah's book it's interesting to read delineation, the last one, a real gem.

We can learn really a lot, observing how the Master answered a question about kingship. It was a contest, because a rebel took the throne of Africa and Masha'allah looked first to the lord of the first house and the Moon to answer to the querent's question. After and only after he looked to the rebel, using the ruler of the 7th house and the Moon, paying attention in what houses in the natal chart they were, what aspects they made and what we to conclude using radical mixed with derivated houses.

Following his teachings I looked to the 10th as the house of victory, the reign, for both fighters. The result of the Moon's TOL was in favor of the Giants.

If we take Saturn as the victory's significator, the Moon picks up Saturn 'till Jupiter, Giant's significator.

Mercury, The Patriots, is received by Saturn but Saturn in any moment transfers its virtue to Mercury. The Moon is received by Mars, planet in the first house, but she falls amiss from Mars and at last through the TOL she transferred the virtue from planets to others that have nothing to do with the Moon and the first house, but have all to do with the Giants.

So, the Giants will win"

And I was right and the only member of the list who got the right answer.

What I can tell you is that my delineation has structure and logic. It was not a random fact.

Some astrologers say that we can't cast a sport horary chart if the querent is not linked personally with the chart.

I can't agree, since we are frequently casting horaries about things that have no direct link with us, for the sake of practice.

If you take the example "the kidnapped girl will be found?" the astrologer who asks this question is not personally involved with the fact, but frequently he is just curious about the outcome, and the question is accepted.

So I don't know why in the specific case of sports the rules have to change.

And they actually worked, as I showed above.
